Playing Field Maintenance

Trustees will retain their twice-yearly schedule to carry out maintenance work, Spring and Autumn and invite villagers to help via village Whatapp group and word of mouth. Specific dates TBC closer to time dependent upon weather conditions. Additional ad hoc work will continue to be carried out as well as regular inspections.

The trustees would like to thank villagers for their support in helping to maintain this shared space, in particular our thanks go to the Baines family for their hard work in clearing dead wood and bracken to create a nature trail in the woods and for facilitating the removal of the decommissioned play area which had sadly reached the end of its viable use. Additionally, our thanks go to all the other families who have volunteered and supported with maintenance work including; strimming, clearing, tidying, bench repairs and emptying the poo bins. You know who you are thank you!

The trustees commissioned an NPTC tree surgeon to produce a full inspection report to address the concern of Ash die back at the playing field. A number of trees have been identified as requiring attention and the priority work has already been completed by Ben Creasey Tree Services with the remaining work scheduled asap with Ben. This important work has a significant cost attached to it and due to the number of Ash trees we have at the playing field, further work over the coming years may well be required. Ongoing fund-raising activities are crucial to maintain and develop this wonderful, shared space.

Finance

The audited playing field accounts accompany this report for the year ending 31st March 2024.

We have also recently sold three new pet plaques to be inserted on the pet remembrance bench amounting to $\pounds 60$ which will appear in next year's accounts. Please do let us know if you would like to purchase a remembrance plaque for your pet. The cost is $\pounds 20$.

Donations from JustGiving amounted to £137.23 for the year ending 31st March 2024.

Looking to the future our hope is to create a new children's play area. Sadly, the previous children's play area equipment had to be removed in 2023 as it was no longer fit for purpose.

A visit to the new children's play area in Manton has recently taken place. We were very grateful to meet with a representative from Manton Parish Council who was instrumental in reaching out to potential funding resources and speaking to families in the village to ensure that the right equipment was chosen. He shared with us all that he had learnt, and we can put all of this to good use when the time comes. We would welcome anyone in the village who would like to get involved in the conversations and fundraising ideas/donations that could make a new children's play area a future reality.
